Thank you for your email.

I can confirm that I have raised this issue with Highways who have advised me that they are, this morning, sending a senior inspector up to the site to inspect and ask the church to remove all items that they consider unlawfully in position on the public highway.

I was also made aware that as an added precaution West Sussex Highways are in the process of raising a temporary traffic regulation order (TTRO) to lower the speed limit to 40mph along that stretch with pedestrian signage to further mitigate any risk to pedestrian safety in the area.

Further to my email yesterday yet more planters have been placed on the side of the road by the entrance to Saint Hill. Please see attached photos taken this morning.
