
There is also a car parked entirely on the verge, which is a public footpath and I have been advised this is a matter for the police, not the council.

Thank you for finally reaching out.. I have been waiting two weeks for the Local Policing Team to make contact with me to discuss our demonstration.

With the event now just 7 days away, I am cautious time is running out to effectively communicate any adjustments necessary to plans to those hoping to attend the protest, and the wider community.

Vehicles parked on a pavement to such an extent that people can no longer use it would be a matter for Sussex Police as an obstruction. We would have no immediate enforcement powers or ability to remove such a vehicle.

Our interventions would be limited to considering physical features such as bollards, or by introducing a TRO to prohibit parking. Given that this particular issue is isolated to one weekend in the year, I would suggest that neither is appropriate in these circumstances
