We are starting the Greenfields School Fund so that parents, alumni and friends of Greenfields can help support the school in achieving our aims of educating and preparing future generations for life using technologies discovered and developed by L. Ron Hubbard.

What will donations be used for?

Donations will go towards building a better and brighter future for current and future students. This might include allowing the school to offer bursaries to help students from all walks of life attend the school, renovating the school premises and buying new equipment, or even developing the Greenfields site to offer more opportunities for application and learning to our students.

What are the advantages of donating?

Donating to our charity is a great way to get the maximum benefit for the students of Greenfields. Firstly, there is no VAT on charitable donations. Not only that, if you are a UK taxpayer and opt to Gift Aid your donation (which simply requires checking a box) the school can claim an additional 25% of the value of your donation. So, if you donate £100, the government will add £25 to this amount and you can claim tax relief on your donation. Win win!

- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit, FastPay Ltd (or Greenfields Educational Trust) will notify you five working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request FastPay Ltd (or Greenfields Educational Trust) to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit by FastPay Ltd or your Bank or Building Society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society.
- If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when FastPay Ltd (or Greenfields Educational Trust) asks you to.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your Bank or Building Society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.
